### **Brief Bio**

Dr Muhammad Shahid Shamim is a distinguished academic, educator, and surgeon with over two decades of experience. He serves as Associate Dean for Graduate Studies and Professor of Medical Education at AKU, where he also contributes to the development, delivery, and governance of undergraduate and graduate programmes.

Beyond his institutional responsibilities, Dr Shamim holds several prominent national and international positions. He is Chair of the Ethics Review Committee (ERC) at the Sindh Institute of Advanced Gastroenterology (SIAG) and a member of the ERC at Shaheed Mohtarma Benazir Bhutto University (SMBBU). He also serves as an Assessor for the World Federation for Medical Education (WFME) and as an International Advisor to the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Glasgow. Additionally, he is an elected member of the Pakistan Medical Association's Central Council and holds adjunct and visiting faculty appointments at leading institutions across Pakistan, including the Centre of Biomedical Ethics and Culture (CBEC).

Dr Shamim has secured multiple competitive research grants and has authored more than 60 publications in national and international peer-reviewed journals. He is the author of two books—*Ethics Training Manual for Healthcare Professionals* and *Ethics in Action: A Guide for Medical Students and Physicians in Pakistan*—and has contributed chapters to several other renowned books.

A committed and impactful educator, Dr Shamim has designed and delivered over 200 faculty development workshops globally, focusing on enhancing educators' knowledge, skills, and professional attitudes to improve the quality of healthcare education and practice. He is widely recognised for his leadership, mentorship, and advocacy for innovation in medical education and research, and continues to inspire colleagues and learners through his dedication and vision.
